(a) The children of citizens, who are displaced from Jammu and Kashmir to any part of India or from unsafe border area of Jammu and Kashmir to a relatively safer place in Jammu and Kashmir from 1990 onwards due to terrorist activities; or

(b) The children of officers belonging to Indian Administrative Services (IAS) or Indian Police Services (IPS) or Indian Foreign Services (IFS) and children of staff belonging to military and paramilitary forces transferred to Jammu and Kashmir to combat terrorist activities and joined the post on or before the last date for submission of application for admission; or

(c) The children of staff and officers of Jammu and Kashmir police engaged in combating terrorism; are eligible under this category.

(i) **Eligibility Criterion For Bachelor of Physical Education Degree Course (B.P.Ed.) :-**

The candidate should be an Indian National and should have passed Bachelor's Degree in any discipline with 50 % marks (49.50% and above to be considered as 50%), (Minimum 45% in case of Backward Class categories ,) (44.50% and above to be considered as 45 %). and having atleast participation in the inter-college /inter-zonal /district / school competition in sports and games as recognized by the AIU/IOA/SGFI/Government of India.

OR

The candidate should have passed Bachelor's Degree in Physical Education with 45% marks (44.50% and above to be considered as 45 %). (Minimum 40% marks in case of Backward Class Categories) (39.50% and above to be considered as 40 %).

OR

The candidate should have passed Bachelor's Degree in any discipline with 45% marks (44.50% and above to be considered as 45 %). (Minimum 40% marks in case of Backward Class Categories (39.50% and above to be considered as 40 %) and studied Physical Education as compulsory /elective subject.

OR

The candidate should have passed Bachelor's Degree with 45% marks (44.50% and above to be considered as 45 %) (Minimum 40% marks in case of Backward Class Categories) (

39.50% and above to be considered as 40 %) and having participated in National /Inter-University /State Competitions or secured 1st, 2nd or 3rd position in Inter-college /inter-zonal /district /school competition in Sports and Games as recognized by the AIU/IOA/SGFI/Government of India.

OR

The candidate should have passed Bachelor's Degree with participation in International Competitions or secured 1st, 2nd or 3rd position in Inter-college /inter-zonal /district /school competition in Sports and Games as recognized by the AIU/IOA/SGFI/Government of India.

OR

The candidate should have passed Bachelor's Degree with 45% marks (44.50% and above to be considered as 45 % (Minimum 40% marks in case of Backward Class Categories) (39.50% and above to be considered as 40 %) and atleast **three years of teaching experience** (for deputed in-service candidates i.e. trained physical education teachers/ coaches).

OR

Candidates who are appearing for the Qualifying Examination in the academic year 2016-2017 are also eligible to apply for CET/ Entrance Examination. Such candidates will become eligible for admission only if they produce Marks Memo/ Degree Certificate of the Qualifying Examination and fulfil the eligibility criteria mentioned above while filling in the Admission Form in the Centralized Admission Process (CAP) after qualifying the B.P.Ed. CET Examination 2017.

Candidates from Out- side Maharashtra Universities will be considered as **Open Category candidates** and criteria applicable to Open category candidates will be applicable to them.,

Note:

- Aggregate marks mean the Grand Total of marks obtained by the candidate at the Degree on which the Class is awarded by the University.
- In case the candidates are awarded Grade/s/CGPA instead of marks, the conversion of Grade/s, CGPA to percentage of Marks would be based on the Formula/Procedure certified by the Board/ University/ Institution from where the candidate has obtained the Bachelor's Degree. The candidate will have to bring the necessary proof to that effect from the University/ Institution.
- The percentage of marks shall be calculated by rounding off to two places after decimal.
- The candidate belonging to SC/ST, DT/VJ, NT (A), NT (B), NT(C), NT(D), OBC and SBC categories should produce "**Caste Certificate**" issued by the Competent Authority and the candidates belonging to ST category should submit "**Tribe Validity Certificate**"
